

INSTRUCTIONS FOR DE-SCALING YOUR KEURIG® HOME BREWER WITH VINEGAR

A. PREPARE

Step 1: Make sure you have 48 ounces of white vinegar on hand. You will also need an empty sink and a ceramic mug (do not use a paper cup.)

Step 2: Empty the water in the Water Reservoir

B. FILL AND CLEAN

Step 1: Pour the vinegar into the Water Reservoir and fill it to the top edge of the clear viewing area.

Step 2: Place the ceramic cup on the Drip Tray and run a brew cycle. DO NOT USE A K-CUP just press the largest cup size setting button for your particular brewer and pour the cycled vinegar residue into the sink.

Step 3: Repeat this process until the Water Reservoir is empty of all vinegar, pouring the contents of the cup into the sink after each cycle. Remember to open and close the lid of the brewer to restart each cycle.

Step 4: Once emptied, fill the water reservoir with fresh water and allow the pump to pull some fresh water into the heater element section of the Brewer. Leave your brewer to stand for 4 hours while still ON. (This allows the water to dilute any vinegar residue from the heater area of your brewer & inside “walls” of your water reservoir container)

Step 5: Once your brewer has been standing for 4 hours (or more), empty the water from inside the reservoir and rinse thoroughly. Once rinsed, fill once again with fresh water for the rinsing part.

C. RINSE

Step 1: Ensure the water reservoir is filled with fresh water.

Step 2: Place a ceramic cup on the drip tray and run a regular brew cycle. Pour the contents of the cup into the sink.

Step 3: Repeat the brew process until the water reservoir is empty.

Step 4: You may need to perform additional brew cycles if you notice any residual taste. This residual taste will disappear.
